Policy on Disruptive Behavior in Class

If a client is disruptive in class, at the discretion of the Facilitator:

- The client may be instructed to stop their disruptive behavior.
- The client may be instructed to leave the class and be counted as absent for the week.
- The client may be instructed to leave the class and be counted as absent for the week, and may be required to meet individually with the Program Director before being allowed to return to class.
- In extreme situations, the client may be Unsuccessfully Discharged from the program.
