



To Applicants for Reduced Program Fees

The regular fee for the Nonviolence Training Program is \$25 to \$35 per week. Under some conditions of extreme hardship these fees can be reduced as much as \$20 per week. Charges for returned checks, late payment fees, absence fees, and missed appointment "no show" fees are not eligible for reduction. Determination of whether or not your fees will be reduced is solely at the discretion of the Nonviolent Alternatives Program Director.

Bring this completed questionnaire to our office. A free appointment will then be scheduled for you to meet with the Program Director to review your application. You must bring copies of your last two years tax returns with you to this appointment. A determination will be made at this meeting if you will be allowed to participate in the program at a reduced fee level.

You must show up for this appointment, and have your tax returns with you, in order to receive consideration for reduced fees. If you do not show up for this appointment, or do not bring the required documents, another appointment will not be scheduled unless you pay a \$60 appointment fee in advance.

What is your name and current address?

List the name, age, and relationship to you of all people who live at the above address.

Do you rent your residence or are you buying it?

If you rent, how much is your portion of the rent?

If you are buying, how much do you owe?

If you are buying, what is the value of your home?

List each utility you pay and the average monthly bill.

List the source of the bond posted on your behalf for you to be released from jail. Include the name of the person posting bond and their relationship to you.

List your weekly household expenses by type and amount.

List each bill that you pay on a regular basis, stating: the amount; whether monthly, weekly or other; and the person paid.

List all outstanding debts you owe by amount and due date.

Have you ever been discharged in bankruptcy? If yes, please state the date of discharge.

List all real estate that you own including the value and any debt associated with the property.

List all vehicles you own including the value and associated debt.

List all other property you own with a value of more than \$100.00.

List all bank accounts in your name or in the name of any person who lives with you. Including the name of the bank, the account number, and the balance of the account.

List all debt owed to you. Include the person that owes you, the amount they owe you, and the date you are expected to be paid.

If you or any person who lives with you is expected to receive money back on your taxes state the amount and the date it is expected.

List your employer and the employers of all persons living with you. Include the amount earned and the length of employment.

If you are unemployed, list the name of all places you have worked in the last two years. Please include the amount earned, the dates of employment and the reason you left.

If you are unemployed, list the names of all places you have applied for employment. Please include the date you applied and if denied work the reason given.

If you have any handicap that prevents you from working, please explain.

If you or any person who lives with you receives income from any source other than employment: state the amount, frequency, and source for the money.

Do you drink alcohol? If yes, please state what form and the amount per week.

Do you smoke or chew tobacco? If yes, please state the amount per week.
